Review of Storm Water Management Permit Application

Dear Ken:

As requested this office reviewed materials provided by Schwebke-Shishin and Associates for the proposed expansion of the Our Lady of Health Church (the former Coral Baptist Church) on University Drive. The materials provided included drainage calculations, drainage plan and survey of existing conditions.

#### **Background**

#### **Project Information**

The applicant proposes to expand on the existing 14,900 SF (footprint) church by constructing a 4,800 SF multi-purpose hall on the existing 2.13 AC lot. The existing parking lot will be reconfigured and grass parking added along the south and east of the property. According to the property appraiser's office the church was built in 1988. This site is located within the East Basin of the Coral Springs Improvement District.

#### **Water Quality Requirements**

The lakes and canals of the East Basin of the Coral Springs Improvement District were designed to provide conveyance of storm water runoff and were not designed to provide water quality treatment. Therefore all projects within the East Basin are required to provide full water quality treatment. The site does not presently provide water quality treatment. The proposed improvements to this site include the addition of 209 LF of exfiltration trench. With minor modifications the trench will provide full water quality treatment rather than just 1" over the site.

#### **Quantity Attenuation Requirements**

The Permit criteria manual requires all projects to provide specified amounts of surface storage as set forth in Table 2. For projects within the East Basin of the Coral Springs Improvement District 0.1 AF/AC of storage is required below elevation 10.8 and 0.81 AF/AC of surface storage is required below elevation 11.6 ft. NGVD. The proposed site modifications meet the required storage for the 10 year storm and increases the compliance with the storage requirements for the 100 year storm.

#### Other Design Considerations

Previously this office identified that the existing canal bank did not comply with the required 4:1 maximum slope to 2 ft. below the water surface. The canal bank is not being altered under this application.

#### Recommendation

The applicant has improved the degree of compliance with district criteria by adding 209 LF of exfiltration trench, adding a control structure and pollutant retardant baffle(s). While this project does

not fully comply with the requirements for new construction, the applicant has included measures to improve the quality of water discharged to district facilities and reduce the quantity of storm water runoff. This office recommends this project be approved subject to the following conditions.

#### **Specific Comments**

- 1. Grass parking is subject to pollution loading and should therefore be considered impervious area for water quality calculations, but may be considered pervious when quantifying runoff.
- 2. This site is located within the East Basin and is therefore required to provide water quality treatment prior to off-site discharge. We estimate this amount to be 0.25 AC-FT. The applicant proposed to install 209 LF of 12′ W x 6′ deep exfiltration trench, with a weir at 9.0 ft. which provides 0.1787 AF of water quality treatment. The applicant proposed design does not meet water quality treatment standards. However, if the applicant were to increase the weir crest to 9.5 ft. they could reduce the width of the trench to 10 ft. while providing water quality treatment amounting to 0.28 AF.
- 3. Table 2 sets forth storage requirements. The Permit Criteria Manual (PCM) requires projects within the East Basin provide 0.10 AF/AC of storage below the 10 year flood elevation and 0.81 AF/AC below the 100 year flood elevation. The proposed Permit Criteria Manual Specifies that this storage is to be computed on gross acreage.
- 4. Following redevelopment, this project will provide 0.41 AF of storage below elevation 10.8 ft. NGVD where 0.213 AF are required, thus satisfying storage requirements for the 10 year storm.
- 5. Presently this site provides an around 37% of the storage required at the 100 year flood elevation, 0.64 AF (out of 1.72 AF). The proposed modifications increase storage by 0.27 AF and provides 0.91 AF at elevation 11.6, thus meeting 53% of the required storage.
- 6. The applicant's stage storage calculations do not appear to correlate with site conditions. They neglect storage provided by the canal bank and fail to account for pervious areas located above the 100 year flood.
- 7. Exhibit 2 from the PCM depicts the minimum canal cross section. Specific features include a maximum slope of 4:1 from the top of bank to elevation 4.5 ft. The existing slope appears to exceed this requirement. No changes to the canal bank depicted on the applicants plans. By not complying with district criteria the applicant assumes responsibility for canal bank stability and addressing any erosion adjacent to this project.
- 8. The plans indicate that this facility will also be used as a charter school. Please provide details of the food preparation / service so staff can evaluate whether a grease trap is required at this time.
- 9. As part of the final paperwork for the project, the applicant will be required to submit an engineering certification addressing new components and the existing system.





#### Conditions of approval

- 1. Authorizes construction of
  - a. 4,800 SF addition to the existing church building
  - 209 LF of 10 ft. wide, 5 ft. high exfiltration trench with a bottom elevation of 4.0 ft.
     NGVD.
  - c. Weir with a crest elevation of 9.5 ft. NGVD.
  - d. Installation of Pollutant Retarding Baffles as indicated on Sheet C-5
- 2. Applicant / Developer must at their own cost, remove all vegetation, except ground cover from the edge of water landward a distance of 20 ft.
- 3. Applicant agrees not to install landscaping (other than grass or ground cover) within district property or within 20 ft. of the edge of water.
- 4. All prior conditions of approval remain in effect unless specifically altered by this permit
- 5. Compliance with requirements for 5 year renewal of existing system is required prior to occupancy of new facility.
- 6. Approval from the CSID is required for changes to the water and sewer system
- 7. Applicant is required to televise existing and proposed sewer systems to confirm integrity and verify that the installation complies with current allowable leakage. Damage to system or seepage in excess of standards must be corrected.
- 8. Prior to the start of construction provide a copy of the approved SFWMD construction dewatering permit.
- 9. Discharge of effluent from construction dewatering activities to district canals is prohibited.

On 5<sup>th</sup> January 2014 we received a solicited quote from Barney's Pump Inc., a sole source supplier, for our Roots blowers. This requested quote is for the blower #9 retrofit. The retrofit of blower #9 is budgeted for in this fiscal period and will complete the work that was needed and similarly done on blowers 10 & 11..
