#### FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

#### **Discussion with Broward County**

Broward County representatives advised they will not be attending any District meeting. There was Board discussion regarding District Counsel sending a letter to the County Attorney and SFWMD regarding unpermitted structures within our District. District staff will write a letter to the County regarding permitting of their structures within the District.

#### SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

## Consideration of Piggyback for Repairs to Lift Station #15

The Board reviewed a quote from Trio Development Corp. at a total cost of \$61,975.16 for repairs to Lift Station #15 as a piggyback off of a contract they have with Broward County.

On MOTION by Mr. Holland seconded by Mr. Mena with all in favor piggybacking off of a Broward County contract with Trio Development Corp. at a total cost of \$61,975.16 was approved.

#### NINTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Piggyback for Membrane Cleaning Chemicals

The Board reviewed a quote from Alkema Solutions, Inc. for a total cost of \$22,833 as a piggyback off of a contract with Palm Beach County.

Consideration of Bid for High Service Pump Building roof Repair (Placeholder)

Mr. McIntosh reviewed the RFP for the high services building roof repair and indicated four bids were received. The lowest responsive bidder is NYC Construction Group, Inc. at a

total cost of \$44,199. Full Cover Roofing is the next lowest at \$44,881. He is still waiting for a references and requested the Board approve repairs at a cost not to exceed \$44,881.

On MOTION by Mr. Mena seconded by Mr. Holland with all in favor high service pump building roof repairs were approved at a cost not to exceed \$44,881 with the bid award pending on positive references.

On April 15<sup>th</sup> and April 22, 2015 the Coral Springs Improvement District published an invitation to bid in the Sun Sentinel as required. The bid spec included removal of all carpet flooring on the first floor of the Administration building and installation of new carpet tiles. At the same time, sent email invitations to bid to nine carpet sellers and installers.

There was only one company that responded and attended the pre-bid meeting as mandated in the bid spec.

My recommendation is to award the replacement of the 1<sup>st</sup> floor carpet with carpet tiles to Affordable Floor Coverings in the amount of \$10.997.06.

Affordable Floor Coverings has been used two other times by Coral Springs Improvement District and we have been satisfied with the quality of their work.

#### INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

#### WARRANTIES

Warranty of Title: The Successful Bidder warrants to the DISTRICT that all goods and materials furnished under the Contract will be new unless otherwise specified and that Successful Bidder possesses good, clear, and marketable title to said goods and there are no pending liens, claims or encumbrances whatsoever against said goods. All work not conforming to these requirements, including substitutions not properly approved and authorized may be considered defective.

Warrantee of fitness for a Particular Purpose: The Successful Bidder warrants the goods and/or services shall be fit for and sufficient for the purpose(s) intended.

Warrantee of Performance: The Successful Bidder warrants that the goods are capable of doing the same or better quality work than other goods of equal value operated under the same conditions.

Warrantee of Material and Workmanship: The Successful Bidder warrants all material and workmanship for a minimum of 10 years from the date of acceptance by the DISTRICT. If within ten years after acceptance by the DISTRICT, or within such larger period of time as may be prescribed by law any of the work is found to be defective or not in accordance with the Contract Documents, the Successful Bidder shall, after receipt of a written notice from the DISTRICT to do so, promptly correct the work unless the DISTRICT has previously given the Successful Bidder a written acceptance of such condition.

The Successful Bidder warrants to the DISTRICT that it will comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations and orders in carrying out its obligations under the Contract.

The Successful Bidder warrants to the DISTRICT that it is not insolvent, it is not in bankruptcy proceedings or receivership, nor is it engaged in or threatened with any litigation, arbitration or other legal or administrative proceedings or investigations of any kind which would have an adverse effect on its ability to perform its obligations under the Contract.

The Successful Bidder warrants that there has been no violation of copyrights or patent rights either in the United States of America or in foreign countries in connection with the work of the Contract. All warranties made by the Successful Bidder together with service warranties and guarantees shall run to the DISTRICT and the successors and assigns of the DISTRICT.

#### APPLICABLE LAWS, ORDINANCE, RULES, CODES AND REGULATIONS

Familiarity with Laws: Notice is hereby given that the Successful Bidder must be familiar with all Federal, State and Local Laws, ordinances, rules, codes and regulations that may affect the work. Ignorance on the part of the Bidder will in no way relieve him from the responsibility of compliance therewith. The DISTRICT is providing the following list of references for the convenience of the Bidder. These requirements may apply under the appropriate circumstance. Inclusion herein does not constitute any waiver by the DISTRICT or any admission or agreement that these laws, orders or rules actually apply to this project. Moreover, the list is not intended to be inclusive and omission shall not be a defense for a Bidder's, Contractor's or Subcontractor sfailure to comply with applicable laws, ordinances, rules, codes or regulations:

Non-Segregated Facilities: The Successful Bidder and each subcontractor shall comply with the Certification of Non-Segregated Facilities supplied in the Bid Documents and this Certification shall be a part of the Bid Documents. By submission of a bid, the Bidder and all subcontractors certify that Bidder has become familiar with the certification and that he will comply with the requirements set forth in the Certification.

Nondiscrimination and Equal Opportunity Employment: During performance of the contract, the successful Bidder agrees as follows:

- (a) The Successful Bidder shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, sex or national origin. The Successful Bidder shall take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment without regard to their race, creed, color, or national origin. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: Employment; upgrading; demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. #### LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT

The successful Bidder agrees that, if the work, or any part thereof, is not completed within the time specified or any extension thereof, the Successful Bidder shall be liable to the DISTRICT in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for each and every calendar day the completion of the work is delayed beyond the time provided in the Contract, as fixed and agreed upon liquidated damages and not as a penalty. DISTRICT shall have the right to deduct from and retain out of moneys that may be then due or which may become due and payable to the Successful Bidder, the amount as such liquidated damages.

#### SCOPE OF WORK

The Scope of Work, Plans and/or Specifications for services and/or goods and materials to be provided under this Project is described in Exhibit "A" hereof. Any Plans associated with the work are referenced in the Scope of Work.

Items shown on the Plans but not noted in the Specifications, and items noted in the Specifications but not shown on the Plans, are to be considered as both shown on the Plans and noted in the Specifications. Any errors or omissions in the Specifications or on the Plans, as to the standards of the work, shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR of the obligation to furnish a satisfactory first class job in strict conformity with the best practice found in structures or in the work of a similar type. The failure of the Bidder to direct the attention of the DISTRICT to errors or discrepancies will not relieve the Bidder, should Bidder be awarded the Contract, of the responsibility of performing the work to the satisfaction of the DISTRICT.

#### **SAFETY**

The Successful Bidder shall be responsible for initiating, maintaining and supervising all safety precautions and programs in connection with the work. The Successful Bidder shall comply with the rules and regulations of the Florida Department of Commerce regarding industrial safety (Fla Statues Section 440.56) and with the standards set forth in the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (OSHA) and its current amendments.

The Successful Bidder shall take all reasonable precautions for the safety of and shall provide all reasonable protection to prevent damage, injury or loss to:

- (a) All employees on the work site and all other persons who may be affected thereby.
- (b) The work and all materials and equipment incorporated therein.
- (c) Other property at the site or adjacent thereto, including trees, shrubs, lawns, walks,

pavements, structures and utilities not designated for removal, relocation or replacement in the course of the work.

#### **REVENUES:**

#### **Assessments**

The District levies a Non-Ad Valorem Assessment on all taxable property within the Coral Springs Improvement District in order to pay for operating and maintenance expenditures.

#### **Permit Review Fees**

Permit fees are based on prior year's revenues.

#### Interest Income

Interest is earned on cash balances in the District's funds on deposit in checking and money market accounts and in various certificates of deposit.

#### **Shared Personnel Revenue**

The District has entered into an interlocal agreement with Pinetree Water Control District. Under the provisions of that agreement the District provides the services of an appropriately licensed field supervisor to Pinetree. Budgeted revenue from this source is \$31,019.

#### **Carry Forward Assigned Funds**

The District is planning to use prior year assigned funds to pay for planned capital purchases and repairs.

#### Administrative:

#### Supervisor Fees

Board of Supervisors may be compensated \$200 per meeting, not to exceed \$2,400 per year. Based on 3 supervisors and 12 meetings per year, the amount should not exceed \$7,200.

#### Salaries and Wages

The total amount of budgeted wages for this Fiscal Year is \$124,846.

#### Special Pay

Special pay is a holiday bonus based on number of years of service. Special pay is budgeted for \$227.

#### **FICA Taxes**

FICA tax is established by the law and currently is 7.65%. Based on salaries of \$124,846 and Supervisors Fees of \$7,200 FICA taxes are being budgeted for \$10,103.

#### Pension Expense

The pension plan was established whereby the employer contributes into the plan annually. Based on salaries of \$124,846 pension expense is budgeted for \$12,484.

#### **Health Insurance**

The District offers each employee Health, Life, Dental and Disability Insurance. In addition, the board members are provided Health and Dental Insurance only. The projected cost to be paid by the District for this fiscal year is \$30,276.

#### Worker's Compensation Insurance

The District's Worker's Compensation Insurance premium is budgeted for \$355.

#### **Engineering Fees**

The District contracts for general engineering services on an annual basis. Based on prior year's experience, the projected amount for this Fiscal Year is \$30,000.

#### Legal Fees

The District currently has a contract with Lewis Longman & Walker, P.A. as legal counsel for the District. This contract includes preparation for monthly board meetings, contract review, etc. Based on prior year's experience the projected amount for this Fiscal Year is \$24,000.

#### **Special Consulting Services**

The District will need to engage a consultant that specializes in legislative codification matters that amend bringing current certain District limitations. Included in the current limitations are bidding threshold requirements, efficiencies gains and benefits inherent in contract administrations and supervisor compensation levels. The anticipated cost for these special services is \$20,000.

#### **Annual Audit**

The District is required by Florida Statutes to arrange for an Independent audit of it's financial records on an annual basis. Based on the current activity level the amount is not expected to exceed \$7,622.

#### **Actuarial Computation-OPEB**

Florida state statutes require the employer to make health coverage available to retirees at the employer's group rate. GASB 45 requires a periodic actuarial assessment of the cost and liability associated with these benefits. The District is budgeting \$435 for this item.

#### **Management Fees**

This service includes management and financial advisory services provided to the District under the Management Contract with Severn Trent Services. This fiscal year the expense is \$52,450.

#### Telephone

Telephone and fax machine expenses are budgeted for this Fiscal Year for \$2,961.

#### **Postage**

#### **Printing and Binding**

Checks, stationary, envelopes, photocopies, etc. The projected expense for this Fiscal Year is \$2,520.

#### **Administrative Building Costs**

This expense represents the costs to operate and maintain the administration building. The projected amount for this cost is \$12,000.

#### Insurance

The District retains Egis Insurance & Risk Advisors as our Insurance Agent, who on a yearly basis arranges the placement of the District insurance for property, general liability, and inland marine coverage. The expected amount for this Fiscal Year should not exceed \$1,000.

#### **Legal Advertising**

The District does most of its legal advertising in the Sun-Sentinel. Expenses include monthly meetings, special meetings, public hearings, etc. Based on prior year's experience the amount should not exceed \$2,000.

#### Contingencies

There are no budgeted expenditures.

All the District's financial records, accounts payable are processed on a main frame computer owned by Coral Springs Improvement District Water and Sewer Fund. The budget amount for this technology is \$15,000 and includes the cost of digital record keeping for engineering/project plans.

#### **Digital Record Management**

The District is providing for the set up and maintenance of digital records of existing infrastructure as-builts as well as providing for the mapping of drainage assets. The amount being budgeted is \$5,000.

#### Office Supplies

Accounting and Administrative Supplies. Projected expense for this year is \$6,000.

#### **Dues, Licenses, Subscriptions**

An annual renewal fee to Florida Assoc. of Special Districts in the amount of \$2,625, an annual Special District fee to the Department of Community Affairs in the amount of \$175, on-going accounting and CPA seminars totaling \$2,200, and \$2,500 for other management related training. The projected expense totals \$7,500.

#### **Promotional Expense**

Pursuant to the provisions contained in the "Contract for Professional Engineering Consulting and Design-Build Services on a Continuing Contract Basis " between the <u>CORAL SPRINGS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT</u>, hereinafter referred to as "OWNER", and <u>Globaltech, Inc.</u>, hereinafter referred to as "FIRM", dated <u>May 7</u>, <u>2015</u>, (hereinafter referred to as "AGREEMENT"), this Work Authorization authorizes the FIRM to provide services under the terms and conditions set forth herein and in the AGREEMENT, which is incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full.

The OWNER desires design-build services related to the <u>Wastewater Treatment</u> <u>Plant Effluent Pump Station Electrical Analyses</u>, hereinafter referred to as the "Specific Project".

#### Section 1 – Terms

The FIRM shall be defined as an individual, corporation or contractor having a direct contract with the OWNER or with any other subcontractor in the performance of a part of the work contracted for under the terms of this Work Authorization with the OWNER.

#### Section 2 – Scope of Work

The FIRM will provide the following services in accordance with Sections 1 and 2 of the AGREEMENT:

The Effluent Pump Station has had multiple electric motor failures and is in need of a comprehensive review of the electrical systems. The VFD for effluent pump P405 is located in MCC 5 which is housed in a building without air conditioning. Modifications have been made to the MCC since the initial construction of the pump station. The VFD's for effluent pumps

P403 and P404 have been replaced entirely with internal components which are no longer manufactured.

This scope of work provides for engineering services to investigate the potential cause(s) of the equipment failures, evaluate status, reliability, and safety of existing electrical equipment, and provide recommendations for remediation. At the end of the investigation, an updated one-line diagram will be created to document the existing conditions.

#### Task 1 – Project Coordination/Management

This task includes project management and engineering required for work.

The FIRM shall contract and work with ADS Engineering for the evaluation.

The FIRM shall conduct the following under Task 1:

- Meet with the OWNER to review the problems observed with the existing electrical system and discuss overall project activity and schedule.
- 2. Develop subcontract with ADS Engineering for engineering services.
- 3. Coordinate with OWNER and subcontractor with follow up site and coordination meetings.

#### Task 2 – Electrical Evaluation

The FIRM and ADS Engineering shall conduct an evaluation of the electrical system. Activities include the following:

- Conduct site field investigation of the existing Effluent Pump Station Electrical System. Review available historical record drawings of existing system. Investigation to include electrical components, wire sizes, and circuit breakers settings.
- 2. Evaluate the safety of the Effluent Pump Station Electrical System and provide recommendations.
- Analyze the status and condition of the current MCC 5 and VFD installation in a non-air-conditioned space, and provide an alternative installation for motor control.

4. Analyze and evaluate the controls for the Effluent Pump Station and provide recommendations for improvement.

#### Task 3 – Report Preparation

The FIRM and ADS Engineering shall provide a report summarizing the finding of the above evaluation with recommendation for improvements. A one-line electrical diagram documenting the existing equipment shall be provided.

#### **Assumptions**

Assumptions for the project are as follows:

- Permits will not be required. No repair, modification, or installation of new equipment is part of this scope of work.
- FIRM is not responsible for limitations, capabilities, and function of the existing equipment and associated wires, conduits, and signals.
- The OWNER shall provide an assistant familiar with plant electrical systems to accompany and assist ADS engineer in gathering all the data in the field from the existing equipment.

#### Section 3 – Location

The services to be performed by the FIRM shall be on the following site or sites:

#### **Coral Springs Improvement District Wastewater Treatment Plant**

#### Section 4 - Deliverables

The FIRM will provide the following Deliverables to OWNER:

- Updated one-line diagram of Effluent Pump Station Electrical System
- Engineering report

#### Section 5 – Time of Performance

Project will commence after execution of this Work Authorization and a Notice to Proceed is issued by OWNER. The FIRM and OWNER agree to the following schedule:

#### Section 6 – Method and Amount of Compensation

- The FIRM shall be paid by the OWNER in accordance with the Florida Prompt Payment Act Florida Statute 218.70-79 and in accordance with the payment method as set forth in Section 6 of the AGREEMENT. The calculations shall begin using the date the invoice was received.
- 2. Total job price: \$11,374.00. Price does not include an allowance.
- 3. The cost for the above scope of services is a lump sum (LS). The LS is based on the materials, methods, and assumptions presented in the scope of services. The LS shall not be greater than the stated amount unless there is an approved increase in the scope of services.
- 4. A Budget Summary for the above LS is provided in Attachment A.

#### Section 7 – Application for Progress Payment

1. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, at the end of each month, the FIRM shall submit to the OWNER for review, an Application for Progress Payment filled out and signed by the FIRM covering the Work completed as of the date of the Application and accompanied by such supporting documentation as is required by the AGREEMENT.

#### Section 8 - Responsibilities

The FIRM shall, under no circumstance, look to the OWNER to provide any labor or equipment for the FIRM. The FIRM shall provide all of the labor and equipment necessary to perform the job or services contracted for at the expense of the FIRM. Property of any kind that may be on the premises, which are the site of the performance of this contract, during the performance of this Work Authorization, shall be at the sole risk of the FIRM.

- **8.1** The OWNER hereby designates <u>David McIntosh</u> as the OWNER's representative.
- **8.2** In addition to applicable provisions of Section 2 of the AGREEMENT, the OWNER will:
  - Provide copies of existing drawings and equipment cut sheets if requested by FIRM
  - Pay for any required permit fees

The FIRM acknowledges and understands that it is an independent contractor in its relationship with the OWNER. The FIRM hereby designates Nico Shaner as the FIRM's representative.

#### Section 9 - Insurance

The FIRM shall provide certificate of insurance to the OWNER setting forth the type and amount of insurance carried by the FIRM and conforming to the minimum requirements set forth in the AGREEMENT.

#### Section 10 - Level of Service

The OWNER shall have the right to terminate said Agreement by giving the FIRM thirty (30) days written notice if the service that is being provided is not maintained at levels necessary to provide the required service. The OWNER will determine in its sole judgment what constitutes a satisfactory level of service.

#### Section 11 - Indemnification

The Firm shall indemnify and hold harmless the Owner and its officers and employees as set forth in Section 11 of the Agreement.

#### ► Well W-7R

The drilling and testing work has been completed. The wellhead flange and welded ring have been installed. The gravel fill tube is the final piece for the well drilling contractor to install. The completion is due next week. Then Globaltech will come in and start their phase of the project.





#### ▶ Well W-4R

The construction phase of this well has been completed. The drilling rig and mud system has been demobilized from the site. Development is now in progress.
